Public Invited to Learn about Improvements at Interchange 14A in Bayonne and Jersey City

New Jersey Turnpike Authority officials will hold a public information center to discuss the improvements at Interchange 14A on the Newark Bay-Hudson County Extension of the Turnpike. Residents, business leaders, public officials and other stakeholders are invited to attend to learn what to expect as construction progresses.

The public information center will be held from 5:00 to 8:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 26, 2015, at the Washington Community School, Multi-Purpose Room, 191 Avenue B, Bayonne. Representatives from the Turnpike Authority will make brief presentations at 5:30 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.

The Turnpike Authority will widen the toll plaza from 11 to 13 lanes and make significant ramp and roadway improvements. A groundbreaking ceremony marking the start of construction was held on March $11^{\rm th}$. The Turnpike Authority held two public hearings and three public information centers before construction began. This meeting is intended to provide all stakeholders with an additional opportunity to learn about the plans and ask questions about the impacts.
